SUBJECT: STATUS UPDATE ON ENHANCED CONTINUOUS VOTER REGISTRATION –
WEEK 3

The Commission would like to update the country on the status of the National Enhanced Voter Registration (ECVR) exercise as it enters its fourth and final week.

1) New Voter Registration and Transfers

As at 5:00 p.m today, the Commission had registered a total of **800,462** new voters out of the Commission's projected target of **4.5 million**. Further, the Commission has serviced a total of **125,266** transfer requests from the existing voters. 2) ECVR in By-Election Areas

The Commission recently concluded the Nguu/Masumba County Assembly Ward by-election and gazetted the winning Candidate. Consequently, ECVR activities that had been suspended as required by law resume this week to afford all eligible citizens in the said County Assembly Ward an opportunity to register as voters. However, ECVR in Kiambaa Constituency as well as Kiagu and Mahoo County Assembly Wards remain suspended.

3) Conclusion

The Commission makes a final call to all Kenyans that are eligible for registration as voters to take advantage of the remaining one week and register. Our staff are in every ward in the country ready to enroll you so that you may exercise your democratic right.
