POSTPONMENT OF THE SMALLHOLDER TEA FACTORY DIRECTOR'S ELECTIONS

The Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission planned to conduct the elections of directors in 54 Smallholder tea factories in Kenya today 28th June 2024 from 7 am to 3 pm. The exercise commenced in following factories:

Momul, Tegat/Toror, Litein/Chelal, Kapkatet/Tebesonik, Kapkoros/Tirgaga/Motigo/Olenguruone, and Mogogosiek/ Boito/Kobel electoral areas.
